



## Installing iPad - Powering Options (Sold Separate)

- 3.) Cat5/6 cable (provided separately)

#### B. Apple Lightning Cable



- 2.) 12W USB Adapter




### Mounting Table Mount to a Wall.

- 1.) Install 1G box in the desired location of the Table Mount
- 2.) Run AC Power or Cat5/6 cables depending on power options desired.




#### Mounting Table Mount to a Wall.

- 3.) Remove the Table Mount foot.
- 4.) Place the foot in the desired location over the 1G box and mark the four mounting holes shown
- 5.) Install 4 drywall anchors in the marked location.
- **6.)** Attach the foot to the anchors with the cable opening facing toward the ground as shown.


- 7.) Insert iPad into Table Mount, see Instruction on reverse side.
- 8.) Connect chosen power cable to the iPad.
- 9.) Hook the Table Mount to the foot as shown then seat the Table Mount on the foot.







#### Securing Table Mount to a table.

- 1.) Remove the Table Mount foot from the Table Mount.
- 2.) Place the foot in the desired location and mark the four mounting holes shown above.
- 3.) Drill pilot holes in the marked locations.
- 4.) Return the foot to the drilled location and secure with screws




**Note:** To run power wire through the table drill a 5th hole in the table at the opening of the foot provided.

5.) Insert the iPad and Run Power shown in previous page.

6.) Latch the front of the Table Mount to the foot and set down towards the rear of the Table Mount.

7.) Use the iPort Security Tool to lock the Table Mount to the mounting plate.
